Recess Equipment

WHAT'S NEW IN CLASS?

GRADE 3

Tolland Green Day is next Tuesday...the children will dress as their "role" child and spend the day visiting/participating in the museums on Tolland Green.

Classes will be finishing up their units on electricity soon.

We are learning to write opinion pieces during Writer's Workshop and the children love giving their opinions!

GRADE 4

All 4th graders have recently visited the UCONN Greenhouse where they enjoyed a scavenger hunt.

We will visit the Mystic Aquarium on May 19th in conjunction with our science unit, Food Webs and Adaptations.

May 28th we will have our Horizon Wings Assembly. A presenter will bring in some impressive birds of prey and the children will be able to see some of the adaptations we have been discussing in our science unit. This is always a popular assembly.

In Social Studies we are finishing a new unit on Economics, focused on personal finance. In Language Arts our reading and writing focus is on non-fiction and we will be working in groups to write a research report. In Math we recently moved from fractions to decimals.

GRADE 5

Fifth grade is getting excited about some really fun upcoming events.

This week all 10 classes will be attending the Boston Freedom Trail field trip. This trip allows the children to walk the Freedom Trail with an experienced guide who is able to show them many of the most important spots in Colonial American History. Visiting the Old North Church, the Paul Revere House, several burying grounds, and eating lunch at Quincy Market are some of the highlights. It is an excellent way to make these historical events very memorable for the students.

In Science, the students continue their learning of human body systems. Students are always interested in this topic, as it helps them understand some of the most important systems in the body. Learning how the brain works with other organs is exciting for everyone. Other systems that 5th grade will be learning about include the respiratory, circulatory, muscular/skeletal, and digestive.

During Language Arts students are wrapping up their writing unit on memoirs. It has given the students a wonderful opportunity to write about some important, memorable events in their lives.

Math is starting to finish up multiplying and dividing with fractions. Soon the teachers will move on to topics related to geometry. The students have done well with fractions, but are looking forward to starting this new unit.
