Morning Drop off

Student drop off is located in the parking lot directly in front of TIS. Students may be dropped off beginning at 8:30. A staff member will be stationed in the drop off lane each morning from 8:30 – 8:45. Students arriving after 8:45 must be walked into the building by a parent or guardian and signed in at the main office. All students must be wearing a mask as they exit family cars.

After School Pick Up

Our end of the day pick student pick up remains in the rear of the building. In order to maintain a safe environment for our students and staff, parents and guardians will not be allowed in the building. Parents and guardians will stand in a line outside the rear of the building and proceed to the rear door one at a time. Parents/guardians will be required to hold an ID up to the door window. Staff will then view the parent/guardian ID and bring the student to the door for dismissal.

Visitor Parking

To help ensure the safety of our students, the driveway in front is reserved for bus traffic only. Please do not drive on the bus lane. Visitor parking is located in front of T.I.S. If you are visiting TIS, please use one of the designated visitor parking spaces located in the front lot.

THREE BIG QUESTIONS:

1.) What does it sounds like?

Choose an instrument that has a sound that inspires you.

2.) How do I make it work?

Choose an instrument that you can handle. Think about your arm length and the size of your fingers.

3.) What is its role in the band?

Choose an instrument that has a part in the music you are interested in playing. Melody, Harmony, Bass Line, Percussion (please remember percussion students learn the xylophone first) Think back to the Tolland High School Band Demo assembly you heard back in June. Which instrument did you enjoy hearing played?

An important note to parents and students:

Choosing an instrument is a commitment. Please decide for yourself what instrument will fit you best. Just because there is an old instrument in the attic doesn't mean it is the right instrument for you. Also, just because a friend is choosing a certain instrument doesn't mean it's the right one for you. Think for yourself. Remember to discuss the three questions when making this big decision.

Small group Band instruction classes meet during the school day on a pull-out basis during some of the Unified Arts class times. Currently, plans are in the works for a 1x per week Full Ensemble rehearsal during the school day. I'll keep you posted!

If you already own a previously used instrument, this may be a convenient method for providing an instrument for your child. Please be sure that it has been serviced recently and is in good playing condition. It can be very frustrating for a beginning instrumentalist to try to play an instrument that needs repair. Gerry's Music Shop (1-800-724-7402) cleans and repairs instruments.

There are several area music stores who rent band instruments on a trial basis. For your convenience, Gerry's Music Shop has a representative who comes to TIS, TMS and THS during the school year on Fridays for instrument pick-ups and deliveries. 5th Grade Band 2022-2023

I am so happy and excited to be the 5th Grade Band Director again this year and I can't wait to see and hear my students from last year! Also, it's not too late to join 5th grade Band. Yes, you can learn an instrument this year even if you did not start last year!

Here is some initial information about 5th grade Band. My plan is to start small group instruction classes during the week of September 19, 2022. These small groups will meet during the school day on a pull-out basis during non-graded class time such as Keyboarding/Spanish. If necessary due to Band sign up numbers, some pull-out groups may meet during Learning Lab time with classroom teacher permission. In the past (before the pandemic), we would also have full ensemble rehearsal once per week. Currently, plans are in the works for a 1x per week Full Ensemble rehearsal during the school day. I'll keep you posted!

Music masks are optional this year, but bell covers will be used on the instruments. (flute and percussion do not use bell covers).

If you're new to Band, several area music stores rent band instruments on a trial basis. For your convenience, Gerry's Music Shop has a representative that visits TIS, TMS and THS during the school year every Friday. Please contact them directly for instrument rental information, Standard of Excellence Book 1, bells covers or cleaning supplies. Online rental is available 24/7.
